- Returning students and new students with coursework from any SUNY institution taken between Fall of 2010 and Fall 2023 follow the 2010 General Education Requirements bachelor's degree programs must include at least 30 credits from seven of ten general education knowledge and skill areas, including Mathematics and Basic Communication.
- Students with coursework taken at a SUNY institution prior to Fall 2010 follow the 2023 General Education framework.
