- Returning students and new students with coursework from any SUNY institution taken between Fall of 2010 and Fall 2023 follow the 2010 General Education Requirements - bachelor's degree programs must include at least 30 credits from seven of ten general education knowledge and skill areas, including Mathematics and Basic Communication.
- Students with coursework taken at a SUNY institution prior to Fall 2010 follow the 2023 General Education framework.
